JUDGING ASSIGNMENTS FOR UNASSIGNED NON REGULAR CLASSES
WILL BE MADE AFTER THE CLOSING DATE.

SPECIAL NON-REGULAR CLASS DESCRIPTIONS

Pre-Novice class is a non-regular class and AKC titles cannot be earned in this class. Qualifying scores will not be required for the awarding of ribbons or prizes. Pre-Novice class is for any handler with a dog that has earned no more than two (2) legs toward their CD title.

All exercises are done on leash. The exercises and order of judging in the Pre-Novice class are:

1. Heel on Leash and Figure 8
2. Stand for Exam
3. Recall
4. Long Sit (1 minute)
5. Long Down (3 minutes)

Wild Card Classes are non-regular classes and AKC titles cannot be earned in these classes. Qualifying scores will not be required for the awarding of ribbons or prizes. Wild Card classes are for any dog that is capable of performing the Novice, Open, or Utility exercises and is eligible under the Obedience Regulations to compete in AKC events. No title is required to enter, and handlers may enter more than one dog. Dogs in these classes may be handled by the owner or any other person, and may be entered in other classes at the same trial. The exercises in each of the Wild Card classes will be performed and judged according to AKC Regulations as in the Novice, Open, and Utility classes except that verbal praise during the exercises is to be encouraged and not penalized. (Good, yes, nice, super, great and atta

boy are some examples of praise that would be allowed.). Handlers may give additional commands, but they will be penalized accordingly. Each handler may choose to select one exercise as a wild card. The exhibitor will have the option of performing the selected wild card exercise, but will receive the full point value regardless of how the dog performs. When checking in, the handler must inform the steward or judge which exercise will be used as the wild card. The exercises will be performed in the same order as the regular Novice, Open and Utility classes. The point values for the exercises, scoring and maximum total points are the same as the regular Novice, Open and Utility classes.

RIBBONS & PRIZES

A list of obedience prizes and trophies offered can be obtained by writing trophy chairperson Jane Derr. You can contact her through the trial secretary. A list of prizes and trophies will be printed in the trial catalog.

HIGHEST SCORING DOG IN REGULAR CLASSES

The IRDTC is offering a H.S. Ribbon and a \$50 cash prize for high scoring dog in trial in regular obedience classes.

HIGH COMBINED

The IRDTC is offering a \$50 cash prize for high combined (Open B/Utility B).

SPECIAL PRIZES

Special prizes will be awarded at the end of the Trial and apply to the Regular Obedience Classes only. Exhibitors wishing to compete in the following classes **MUST REGISTER** with the awards tabulator at the registration table prior to entering the ring. H.S. Junior Handler, 17 years or younger, all classes, prize. H.S. Senior Handler, 60 years or older, all classes, prize. Information on other prizes available will be contained in the catalog.

Prizes or ribbons, 1st through 4th place, will be awarded in all regular classes, optional titling classes, and non-regular classes. Prizes will be awarded in the ring by the judge at the end of each class.

Qualifying ribbons, dark green in color, will be awarded to all dogs receiving a qualifying score in regular classes and in optional titling classes.

EXHIBITORS: IF YOU WOULD LIKE TO PURCHASE A 2 DAY CATALOG, PLEASE PREPAY WITH YOUR ENTRY FEES. WE WILL BE MAKING ENOUGH CATALOGS FOR PREPAY EXHIBITORS AND ONLY A MINIMAL AMOUNT THEREAFTER. IF YOU DO NOT PREPAY FOR YOUR CATALOG AND WANT TO PURCHASE ONE ON EITHER DAY, YOU MAY NOT BE ABLE TO GET ONE.

FOOD CONCESSION will be available for this trial weekend. We will also be offering complimentary coffee each morning until 9:30 A.M.

ALL DOGS SHOULD BE PRESENT AT LEAST 30 MINUTES PRIOR TO JUDGING THE HANDLER IS SOLELY RESPONSIBLE FOR HAVING THE DOG AT RINGSIDE. THE JUDGE NEED NOT WAIT FOR ANY DOG HOLDING UP A CLASS. **WE WILL NOT CALL FOR YOU.**

Exhibitors should follow their veterinarian's recommendation to assure their dogs are free of internal parasites, any communicable diseases, and have appropriate vaccinations.

It is expressly understood that the exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may at the discretion of the Trial Committee, be asked to leave the trial site. In such case, no refund of any entry fees will be made.

The Indian River Dog Training Club, its agents, etc., assume no responsibility for any loss, damage or injury sustained by exhibitors, handlers or to any of their dogs or property and further assumes no responsibility for injury to children.

EXHIBITORS ARE ASKED NOT TO SET UP CRATES AND CHAIRS ON FRIDAY EVENING UNTIL ALL MATS AND RING GATES ARE IN PLACE. EXHIBITORS WILLING TO ASSIST WITH SETUP WILL BE PERMITTED TO BRING IN CRATES & CHAIRS ON FRIDAY EVENING.

The use of spiked or other "special" collars or anything hanging from the collar is prohibited at this or any other obedience trial. Exercise pens **are not allowed** inside the building!! **LIMITED SPACE PROHIBITS DOGS NOT ENTERED IN THE TRIAL!** WE ARE REQUESTING ALL EXHIBITORS TO USE THE MAIN ENTRANCE DOORS ONLY FOR ENTERING AND EXITING THE BUILDING. DO NOT USE THE DOORS ON THE SIDES OF THE BUILDING!

EXHIBITORS ARE RESPONSIBLE FOR PICKING UP AFTER THEIR DOGS. PLEASE USE THE DESIGNATED AREA AT THE TRIAL SITE TO EXERCISE YOUR DOGS.

MOVEUPS

MOVEUPS IN RALLY CLASSES AND REGULAR OBEDIENCE CLASSES WILL BE ALLOWED. The request for a moveup must be in writing and presented to the trial secretary by the conclusion of each trial. **MOVEUPS FOR SUNDAY'S TRIAL MUST BE PRESENTED TO THE TRIAL SECRETARY BY THE END OF THE TRIALS ON SATURDAY. NO MOVEUPS WILL BE ACCEPTED ON SUNDAY MORNING.** MOVE UP FORMS WILL BE AVAILABLE AT THE RALLY RING AND AT THE SECRETARY'S TABLE ON SATURDAY FOR THOSE EXHIBITORS WHO NEED THEM.

Entry fees shall **not** be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by a Veterinarian or Judge or barred from competition by action of the Show Committee. One half of the entry fee will be refunded upon request to the trial secretary for a bitch coming in season after the closing date of entries for this obedience trial, provided the secretary is notified prior to the date of the trial. Full refunds will be made for bitches that come in season provided the secretary is notified prior to the entry closing date. No refunds will be made on the day of the trial.

NOTE TO RALLY EXHIBITORS: YOU ARE EXPECTED TO UNDERSTAND THE RALLY RULES AND UNDERSTAND WHICH RALLY CLASS (A OR B) AT ANY LEVEL TO ENTER. THE TRIAL SECRETARY WILL NOT ADVISE YOU WHICH CLASS (A OR B) YOU SHOULD ENTER. The rules differ between the Rally Novice class and Rally Advanced/Rally Excellent classes. BE ADVISED THAT YOUR LEG WILL **NOT** COUNT IF YOU EARN IT IN THE WRONG CLASS! If you have any questions on which class to enter, consult the AKC rules for Rally at www.akc.org.

THE RALLY ADVANCED AND EXCELLENT CLASSES WILL BE ARRANGED ACCORDING TO JUMP HEIGHT - **SMALL TO LARGE FOR THE TRIAL WEEKEND**. IF YOUR RALLY CLASS REQUIRES A JUMP HEIGHT, YOU MUST SUPPLY A JUMP HEIGHT ON YOUR ENTRY FORM OR THE TRIAL SECRETARY WILL NOT ACCEPT YOUR ENTRY.

AGREEMENT

I (we) agree that the club holding this event has the right to refuse this entry for cause which the club shall deem sufficient. In consideration of the acceptance of this entry and of the holding of this event and of the opportunity to have the dog judged and to win prizes, ribbons, or trophies, I (we) agree to hold the AKC, the event-giving club, their members, directors, governors, officers, agents, superintendents or event secretary and the owner and/or lessor of the premises and any provider of services that are necessary to hold this event and any employees or volunteers of the aforementioned parties, and any AKC approved judge, judging at this event, harmless from any claim for loss or injury which may be alleged to have been caused directly or indirectly to any person or thing by the act of this dog while in or about the event premises or grounds or near any entrance thereto, and I (we) personally assume all responsibility and liability for any such claim; and I (we) further agree to hold the aforementioned parties harmless from any claim for loss, injury or damage to this dog.

Additionally, I (we) hereby assume the sole responsibility for and agree to indemnify, defend and save the aforementioned parties harmless from any and all loss and expense (including legal fees) by reason of the liability imposed by law upon any of the aforementioned parties for damage because of bodily injuries, including death at any time resulting therefrom, sustained by any person or persons, including myself (ourselves), or on account of damage to property, arising out of or in consequence of my (our) participation in this event, however such injuries, death or property damage may be caused, and whether or not the same may have been caused or may be alleged to have been caused by the negligence of the aforementioned parties or any of their employees, agents, or any other persons. **I (WE) AGREE THAT ANY CAUSE OF ACTION, CONTROVERSY OR CLAIM ARISING OUT OF OR RELATED TO THE ENTRY, EXHIBITION OR ATTENDANCE AT THE EVENT BETWEEN THE AKC AND THE EVENT-GIVING CLUB (UNLESS OTHERWISE STATED IN ITS PREMIUM LIST) AND MYSELF (OURSELVES) OR AS TO THE CONSTRUCTION, INTERPRETATION AND EFFECT OF THIS AGREEMENT SHALL BE SETTLED BY ARBITRATION PURSUANT TO THE APPLICABLE RULES OF THE AMERICAN ARBITRATION ASSOCIATION. INSTRUCTIONS

1. (Variety) If you are entering a dog of breed in which there are varieties for show purposes, please designate the particular variety you are entering, i.e., Cocker Spaniel (solid color black, ASCOB, parti-color), Beagles (not exceeding 13 in., over 13 in. but not exceeding 15 in.), Dachshunds (longhaired, smooth, wirehaired), Coonies (rough, smooth), Bull Terriers (colored, white), Manchester Terriers (standard, toy), Chihuahuas (smooth coat, long coat), English Toy Spaniels (King Charles and Ruby, Blenheim and Prince Charles), Poodles (toy, miniature, standard).
2. The following categories of dogs may be entered and shown in Best of Breed competition: Dogs that are Champions of Record and dogs which, according to their owners' records, have completed the requirements for a championship, but whose championships are unconfirmed. The showing of unconfirmed Champions in Best of Breed competition is limited to a period of 90 days from the date of the show where the dog completed the requirements for a championship.
3. (Event Class) Consult the classification in this premium list. If the event class in which you are entering your dog is divided, then, in addition to designating the class, specify the particular division of the class in which you are entering your dog, i.e., age division, color division, weight division.
4. A dog must be entered in the name of the person who actually owned it at the time entries for an event closed. If a registered dog has been acquired by a new owner it must be entered in the name of its new owner in any event for which entries closed after the date of acquisition, regardless of whether the new owner has received the registration certificate indicating that the dog is recorded in his name. State on entry form whether transfer application has been mailed to the AKC. (For complete rules, refer to Chapter 11, Section 3.)
