ENTRY FEES

REGULAR & OPTIONAL TITLING OBEDIENCE CLASSES ENTRY FEE EACH DAY FOR REGULAR & OPTIONAL TITLING OBEDIENCE CLASSES SHALL BE \$25.00 per dog for the FIRST entry in Regular or Optional Obedience Classes and \$14.00 per dog for additional entry of the SAME DOG in Regular or Optional Titling Obedience Classes.

NON-REGULAR OBEDIENCE CLASSES

ENTRY FEE FOR ALL NON-REGULAR OBEDIENCE CLASSES SHALL BE \$14.00 PER DOG, PER DAY.

RALLY CLASSES

ENTRY FEE EACH DAY FOR RALLY CLASSES SHALL BE \$25.00 per dog for the FIRST entry in rally classes and \$14.00 per dog for additional entry of the SAME DOG in rally classes.

Effective September 1, 2011, Event Service Fees on AKC events will be \$3.00 for the first entry and \$3.00 for each additional entry of the same dog (regular classes only). A Recording Fee of \$3.00 will also be collected for each entry. For Rally trials, a Recording Fee of \$3.50 for first entry and \$3.00 for each additional entry of the same dog shall be collected. These fees are to be collected by the show-giving club and paid to the American Kennel Club. The fees are included in the entry fee for this trial.

Entry fees shall not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by a Veterinarian or Judge or barred from competition by action of the Show Committee. One half of the entry fee will be refunded upon request to the trial secretary for a bitch coming in season after the closing date of entries for this obedience trial, provided the secretary is notified prior to the date of the trial. Full refunds will be made for bitches that come in season provided the secretary is notified prior to the entry closing date. No refunds will be made on the day of the trial.

NOTE TO RALLY EXHIBITORS: YOU ARE EXPECTED TO UNDERSTAND THE RALLY RULES AND UNDERSTAND WHICH RALLY CLASS (A OR B) AT ANY LEVEL TO ENTER. THE TRIAL SECRETARY CANNOT AND WILL NOT ADVISE YOU WHICH CLASS (A OR B) YOU SHOULD ENTER. The rules differ between the Rally Novice class and Rally Advanced/Rally Excellent classes. BE ADVISED THAT YOUR LEG WILL NOT COUNT IF YOU EARN IT IN THE WRONG CLASS! If you have any questions on which class to enter, consult the AKC rules for Rally at www.akc.org.

The Rally Advanced and Excellent Classes will be arranged according to jump height - **Small to Large on Saturday and Large to Small on Sunday**. If your Rally Class requires a jump height, you must supply a jump height on your entry form or the Trial Secretary will not accept your entry.

I (we) agree that the club holding this event has the right to refuse this entry for cause which the club shall deem sufficient.
