REGULAR & OPTIONAL TITLING OBEDIENCE CLASSES

ENTRY FEE EACH DAY/EACH TRIAL FOR REGULAR & OPTIONAL TITLING
OBEDIENCE CLASSES (*Sunday only*) SHALL BE \$23.00 per dog for the FIRST
entry in Regular or Optional Obedience Classes and \$14.00 per dog for
additional entry of the SAME DOG in Regular or Optional Titling Obedience
Classes.

NON-REGULAR OBEDIENCE CLASSES

ENTRY FEE FOR ALL NON-REGULAR OBEDIENCE CLASSES, WHICH WILL BE
OFFERED ON SUNDAY ONLY, SHALL BE \$14.00 PER DOG.

RALLY CLASSES

ENTRY FEE EACH DAY/EACH TRIAL FOR RALLY CLASSES SHALL BE \$23.00
per dog for the FIRST entry in rally classes and \$14.00 per dog for additional
entry of the SAME DOG in rally classes.

Effective January 1, 2008, Event Service Fees on all AKC events will be \$3.00 for the
first entry and \$3.00 for each additional entry. This will be in addition to the existing
\$.50 recording fee. These fees are to be collected by the show-giving club and paid to
the American Kennel Club. The fees are included in the entry fee for this trial.

Entry fees shall not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified,
excused by a Veterinarian or Judge or barred from competition by action of the Show
Committee. One half of the entry fee will be refunded upon request to the trial
secretary for a bitch coming in season after the closing date of entries for this
obedience trial, provided the secretary is notified prior to the date of the trial. Full
refunds will be made for bitches that come in season provided the secretary is notified
prior to the entry closing date. No refunds will be made on the day of the trial.

NOTE TO RALLY EXHIBITORS: YOU ARE EXPECTED TO UNDERSTAND THE
RALLY RULES AND UNDERSTAND WHICH RALLY CLASS (A OR B) AT ANY
LEVEL TO ENTER. THE TRIAL SECRETARY WILL NOT ADVISE YOU WHICH
CLASS (A OR B) YOU SHOULD ENTER. The rules differ between the Rally Novice
class and Rally Advanced/Rally Excellent classes. BE ADVISED THAT YOUR LEG
WILL NOT COUNT IF YOU EARN IT IN THE WRONG CLASS! If you have any
questions on which class to enter, consult the AKC rules for Rally at www.akc.org.

THE RALLY ADVANCED AND EXCELLENT CLASSES WILL BE ARRANGED
ACCORDING TO JUMP HEIGHT - **LARGE TO SMALL FOR THE TRIAL
WEEKEND**. IF YOUR RALLY CLASS REQUIRES A JUMP HEIGHT, YOU MUST
SUPPLY A JUMP HEIGHT ON YOUR ENTRY FORM OR THE TRIAL SECRETARY
WILL NOT ACCEPT YOUR ENTRY.

ALL DOGS SHOULD BE PRESENT AT LEAST 30 MINUTES PRIOR TO JUDGING. THE HANDLER IS SOLELY RESPONSIBLE FOR HAVING THE DOG AT RINGSIDE. THE JUDGE NEED NOT WAIT FOR ANY DOG HOLDING UP A CLASS. **WE WILL NOT CALL FOR YOU**.

Exhibitors should follow their veterinarian's recommendation to assure their dogs are free of internal parasites, any communicable diseases, and have appropriate vaccinations.

It is expressly understood that the exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the Trial Committee, be asked to leave the trial site. In such case, no refund of any entry fees will be made.

MOVEUPS

MOVEUPS IN RALLY CLASSES AND REGULAR OBEDIENCE CLASSES WILL BE ALLOWED. The request for a moveup must be in writing and presented to the trial secretary by the conclusion of each trial. **MOVEUPS FOR SUNDAY'S TRIAL MUST BE PRESENTED TO THE TRIAL SECRETARY BY THE END OF THE TRIALS ON SATURDAY. NO MOVEUPS WILL BE ACCEPTED ON SUNDAY MORNING.** MOVE UP FORMS WILL BE AVAILABLE ON SATURDAY FOR THOSE EXHIBITORS WHO NEED THEM.

Trial entries will be limited to 8 hours of judging time per day for each judge. Entries will be taken as received until the 8 hour limit is reached or entries close. On Sunday, Regular Class entries will be given first priority followed by the Optional Titling Classes, followed by the Non-Regular Classes.

SPECIAL NON-REGULAR CLASS DESCRIPTIONS

Pre-Novice class is a non-regular class and AKC titles cannot be earned in this class. Qualifying scores will not be required for the awarding of ribbons or prizes. Pre-Novice class is for any handler with a dog that has earned no more than two (2) legs toward their CD title.

All exercises are done on leash. The exercises and order of judging in the Pre-Novice class are:

1. Heel on Leash and Figure 8
2. Stand for Exam
3. Recall
4. Long Sit (1 minute)
5. Long Down (3 minutes)

Wild Card Classes are non-regular classes and AKC titles cannot be earned in these classes. Qualifying scores will not be required for the awarding of ribbons or prizes. Wild Card classes are for any dog that is capable of performing the Novice, Open, or Utility exercises and is eligible under the Obedience Regulations to compete in AKC events. No title is required to enter, and handlers may enter more than one dog. Dogs in these classes may be handled by the owner or any other person, and may be entered in other classes at the same trial. The exercises in each of the Wild Card classes will be performed and judged according to AKC Regulations as in the Novice, Open, and Utility classes except that verbal praise during the exercises is to be encouraged and not penalized. (Good, yes, nice, super, great and atta boy are some examples of praise that would be allowed.). Handlers may give additional commands, but they will be penalized accordingly. Each handler may choose to select one exercise as a wild card. The exhibitor will have the option of performing the selected wild card exercise, but will receive the full point value regardless of how the dog performs. When checking in, the handler must inform the steward or judge which exercise will be used as the wild card. The exercises will be performed in the same order as the regular Novice, Open and Utility classes. The point values for the exercises, scoring and maximum total points are the same as the regular Novice, Open and Utility classes.

RIBBONS & PRIZES

A list of obedience prizes and trophies offered can be obtained by writing trophy chairperson Jane Derr. You can contact her through the trial secretary. A list of prizes and trophies will be printed in the trial catalog.

HIGHEST SCORING DOG IN REGULAR CLASSES

The IRDTC is offering a H.S. Ribbon and a \$50 cash prize for high scoring dog in trial in regular obedience classes.

HIGH COMBINED

The IRDTC is offering a \$50 cash prize for high combined (Open B/Utility B).

SPECIAL PRIZES

Special prizes will be awarded at the end of the Trial and apply to the Regular Obedience Classes only. Exhibitors wishing to compete in the following classes **MUST REGISTER** with the awards tabulator at the registration table prior to entering the ring. H.S. Junior Handler, 17 years or younger, all classes, prize. H.S. Senior Handler, 60 years or older, all classes, prize. Information on other prizes available will be contained in the catalog.

Prizes or ribbons, 1st through 4th place, will be awarded in all regular classes, optional titling classes, and non-regular classes. Prizes will be awarded in the ring by the judge at the end of each class.

Qualifying ribbons, dark green in color, will be awarded to all dogs receiving a qualifying score in regular classes and in optional titling classes.

Prizes must be picked up the day of the trial. None will be mailed. Prizes NOT picked up become the property of IRDTC and will be awarded at a later trial. A qualifying score of 170 points or better in the regular obedience classes and in the optional titling classes is required to win a prize. If the Highest Scoring Dog/handler team is not present or represented when the prizes are awarded, that prize WILL NOT BE PRESENTED.
